

Conditions of participation for the competition to win workplaces in the startup space in Zurich Schlieren

These conditions of participation refer to the competition which PostFinance Ltd (hereinafter referred to as "PostFinance") is running on selected social media platforms in 2020.

Eligibility and registration

1. All individuals who are resident or domiciled in Switzerland and are at least 18 years of age at the time of registration are eligible to take part.
2. The competition will run between 1 January 2020 and 31 December 2020.
3. By participating in the competition, or by submitting the application form, you agree to accept these conditions of participation.

Selection of the winners

4. PostFinance will select three winners from all permissible entries at its own discretion.
5. Depending on the number of employees/people involved in the start-up, a maximum of two workplaces in accordance with section 7 below will be financed per winner.
6. The pre-selection will be carried out in association with the Institut für Jungunternehmen (IFJ).

The prize and how it may be used

7. As a prize, PostFinance will bear the rental costs for a maximum of six workplaces (a maximum of two workplaces per winner) in the startup space in Zurich Schlieren, which is owned by the Institut für Jungunternehmen (IFJ). The following are included in the rental costs:
 - Use of fully furnished workplaces
 - Daily cleaning of the sanitary facilities
 - Weekly office cleaning
 - High-speed WLAN
 - Shared use of sanitary facilities and kitchens
 - Use of vending machines
 - Free shared use of the indoor lounge, networking area and roof terrace
 - Secure entry 24/7 with your own key
 The rental costs for the workplaces will be borne by PostFinance for a maximum of six months, in agreement with each winner. The rental contract will be drawn up directly between the lessor of the premises and the relevant winner. The winners must start using the workplaces within the time period specified by PostFinance.
8. The prize is not transferable. Exchange for cash is not possible.
9. The winner's claim to the prize will be forfeited if incorrect details are provided on the registration form or if the workplaces are sublet.
10. The components, deadlines and appointments agreed with the winner must be observed in order to redeem the prize.

Exclusion of entries

11. PostFinance has the sole and final decision regarding admission to the competition. It may refuse participation in the competition if this could result in disadvantages for PostFinance or third parties. It may refuse participation especially if there is a violation of the law, customs or public morals and/or these conditions of participation.
12. If PostFinance discovers a violation of these conditions of participation during the competition, it is entitled to exclude the associated contestants immediately from the competition and to refuse to award them any prize.

Data protection

13. Information about the contestants provided on the registration form will not be passed on for the use of third parties, with the exception of the Institut für Jungunternehmen (IFJ).
14. The names of the winners and their prizes will, however, be made public to third parties.
15. Each winner expressly agrees that PostFinance may mention them as such in social media and other electronic or printed PostFinance communications in text, image and video.

Limitation of liability

16. To the extent permitted by law, PostFinance is excluded from any liability.

Judge's decision and correspondence

17. Any right of appeal is excluded. No reason will be given for the selection of the winners or for the rejection of entries, and the contestants have no right to information.

Place of jurisdiction and applicable law

18. The competition is subject to Swiss law. In the event of any disputes, the place of jurisdiction is Berne.
